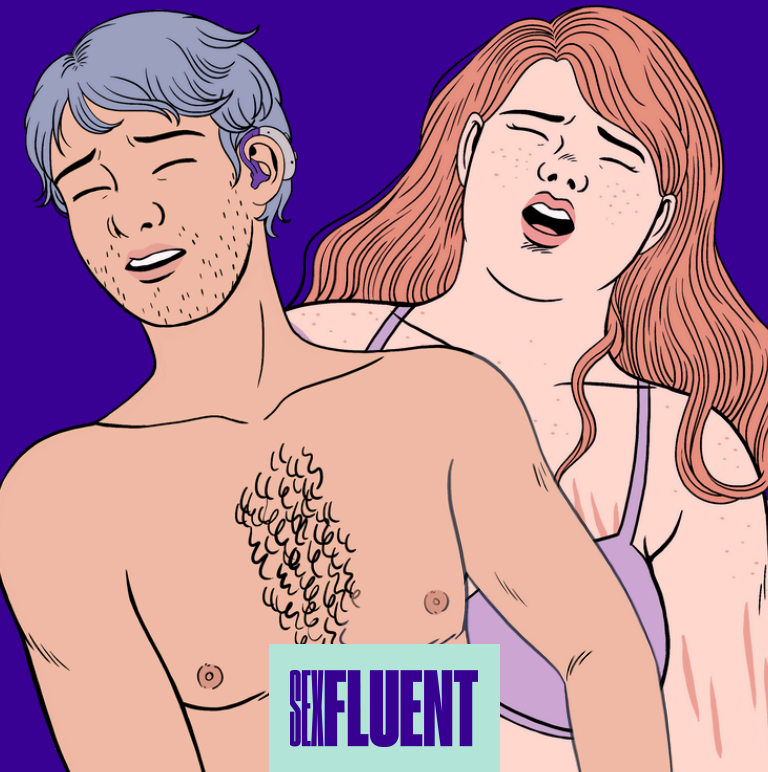


GET PrEP'ED FOR SEX!



SEXFLUENT

PrEP stands for pre-exposure prophylaxis. It's like birth control, but for HIV. PrEP is for anyone who is HIV-negative and looking to prevent HIV.

PrEP is a medication that is highly effective at preventing HIV when taken as prescribed.

Most people who take PrEP report no side effects. PrEP is safe for trans folks on hormone replacement therapy, as it does not reduce hormone levels.

If you want to take PrEP, talk to a healthcare provider. Taking PrEP also involves seeing a healthcare provider regularly for HIV testing, screening for other sexually transmitted infections (STIs) and monitoring for possible side effects.

Remember: PrEP only helps to prevent HIV – it does not protect against other STIs (such as chlamydia, gonorrhea and syphilis). It also does not prevent pregnancy! Consider using condoms and lube with PrEP for maximum protection.
