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CLIENT DEMOGRAPHICS

Between January 1st and March 31st 2026, 69 individuals received services through the Mesa Mobile Outreach Team, which is a core component of the Renfrew County Mobile Substance Use Service. **Demographics have been collected for 41 of the 69 clients reached.** Below are the demographics of clients served*.

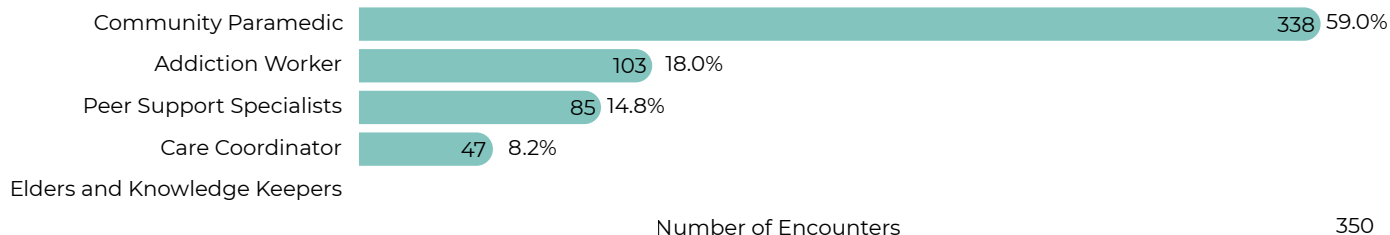

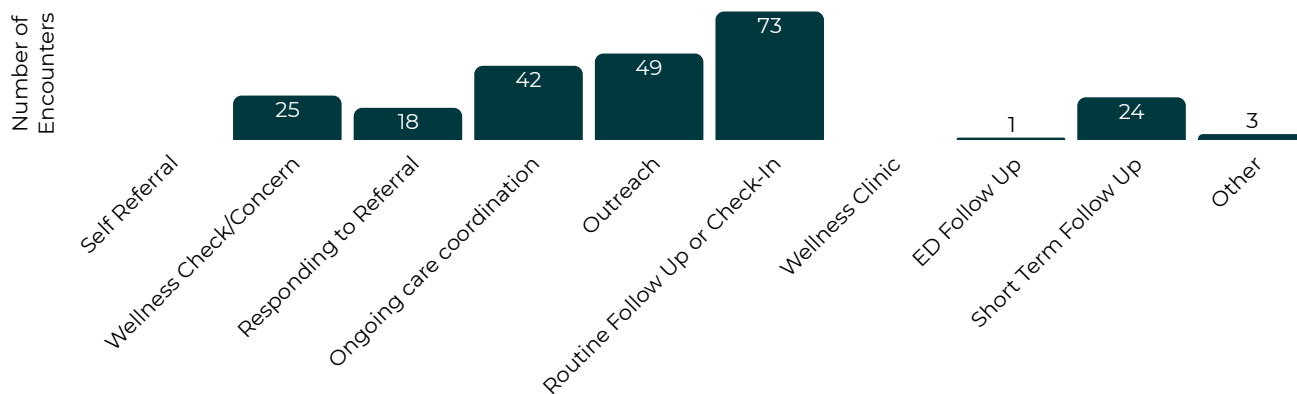
ENCOUNTERS

Between January 1st and March 31st 2026, there were 573 total encounters through the Mesa Mobile Community Outreach Team Expansion.

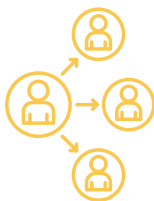

The Mobile Outreach Team has provided **143** referrals to external supports.

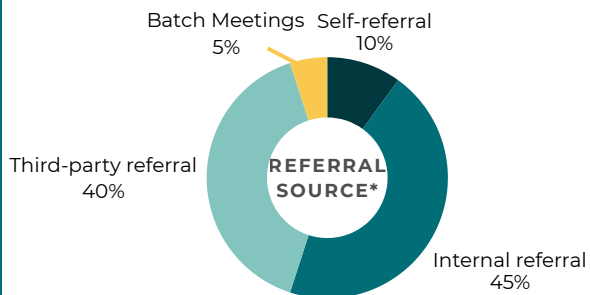

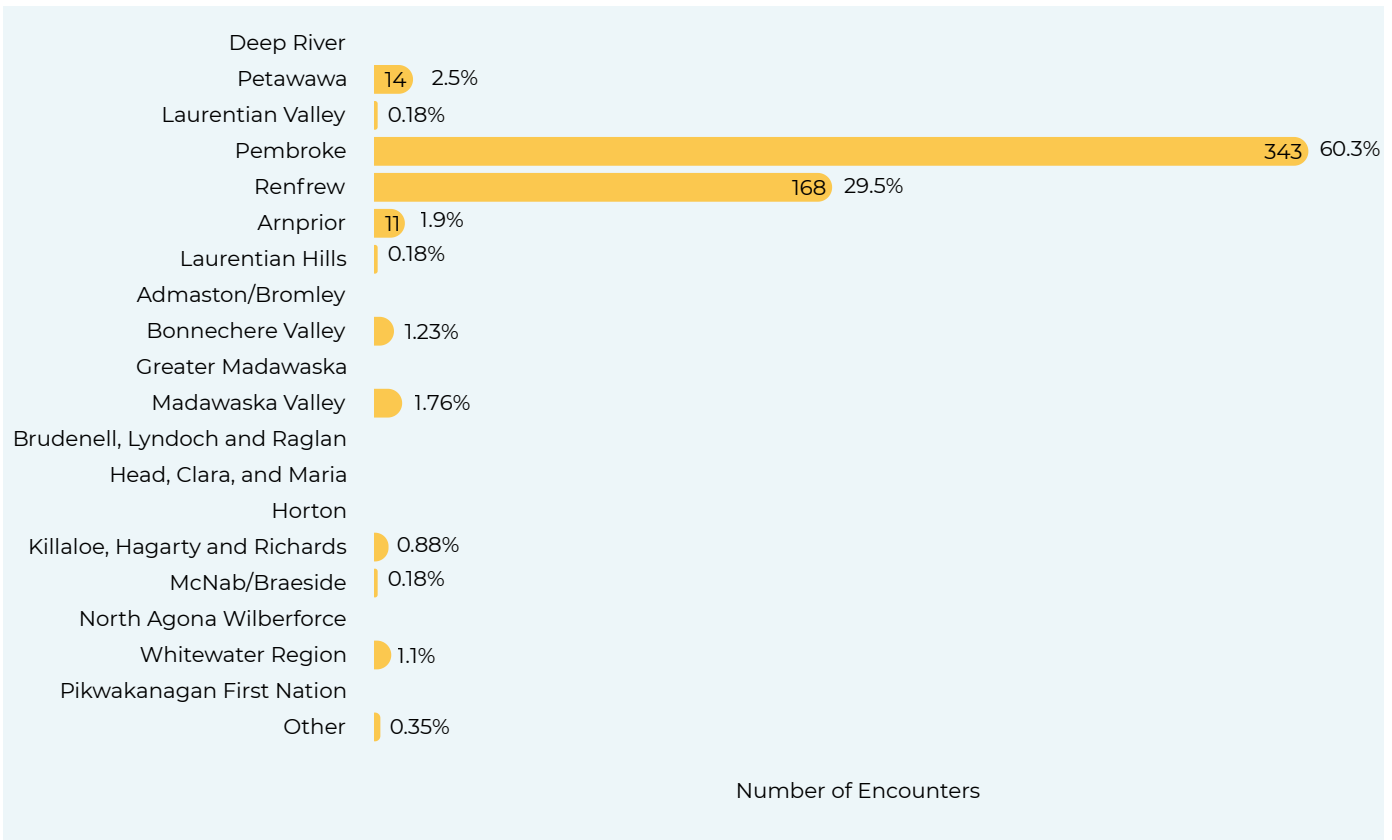
Referral Source*



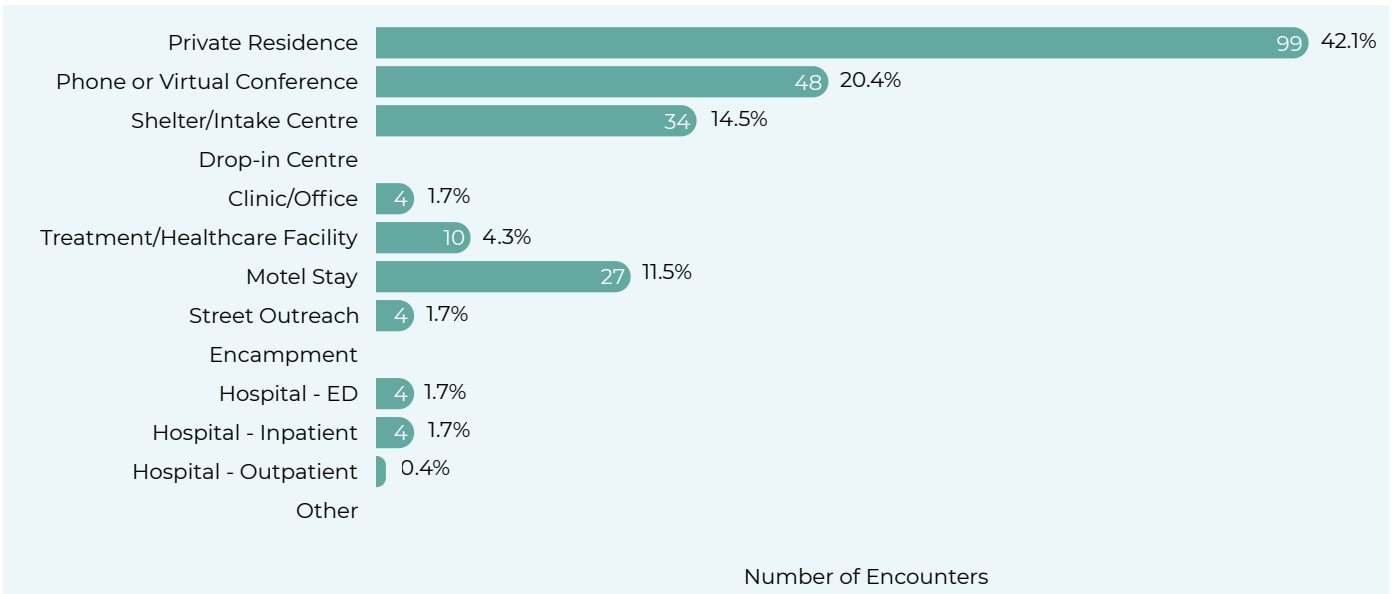

Location of the Encounter

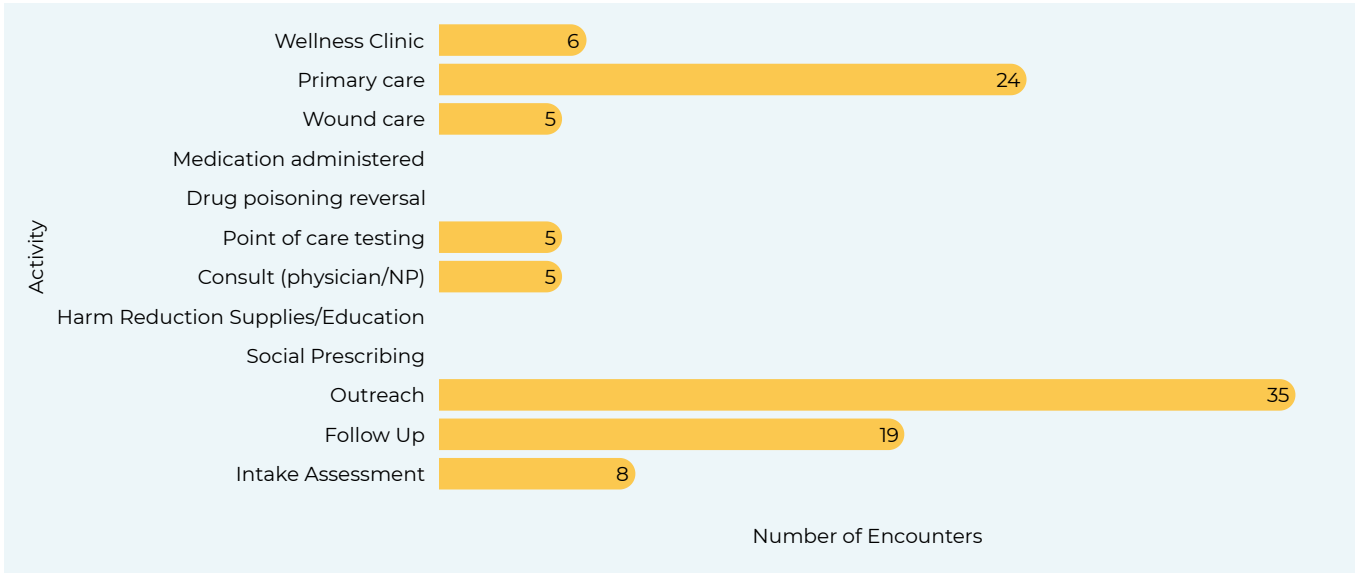

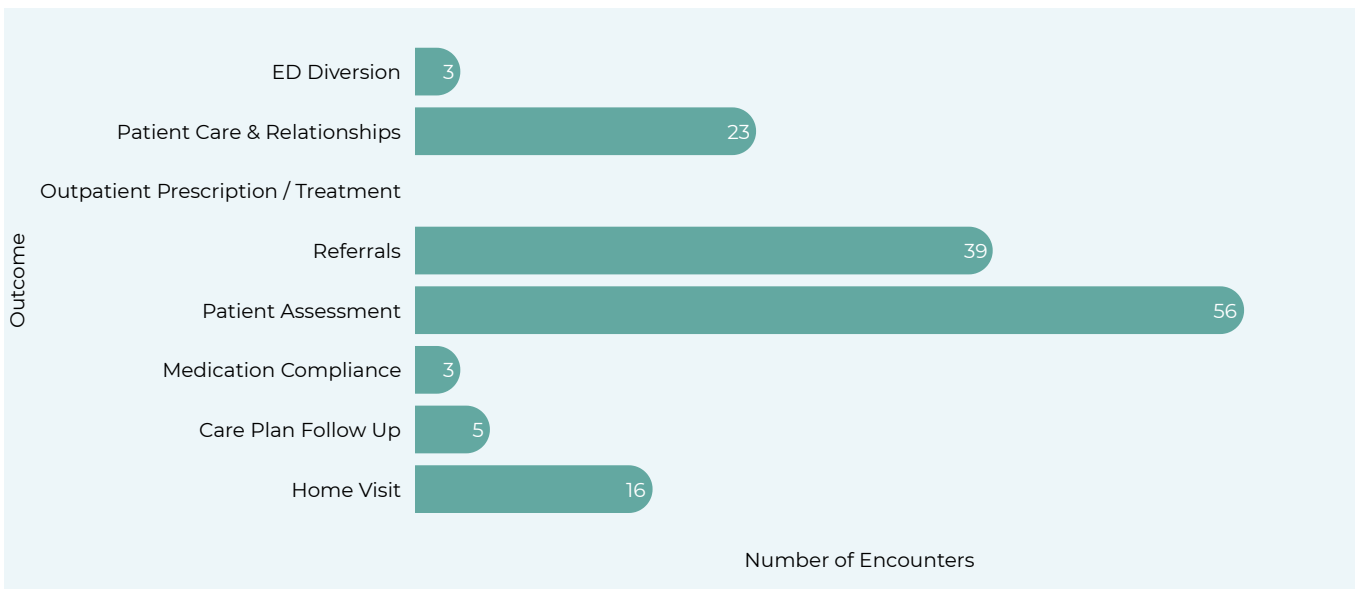
ENCOUNTER METRICS- COMMUNITY PARAMEDICS

Care Plan Outcomes

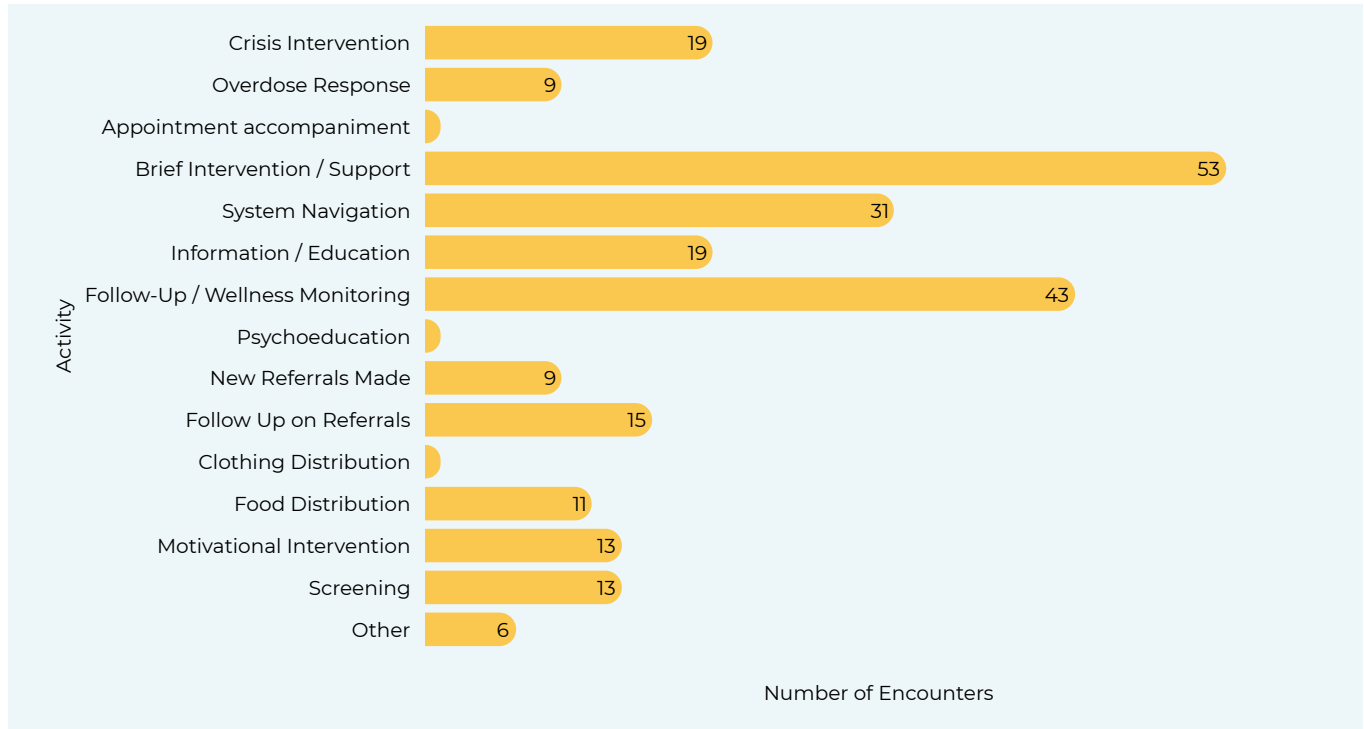


** Community Paramedic data was collected from an EMR system, and not from the encounter forms. As such, different categories were collected and reported on.

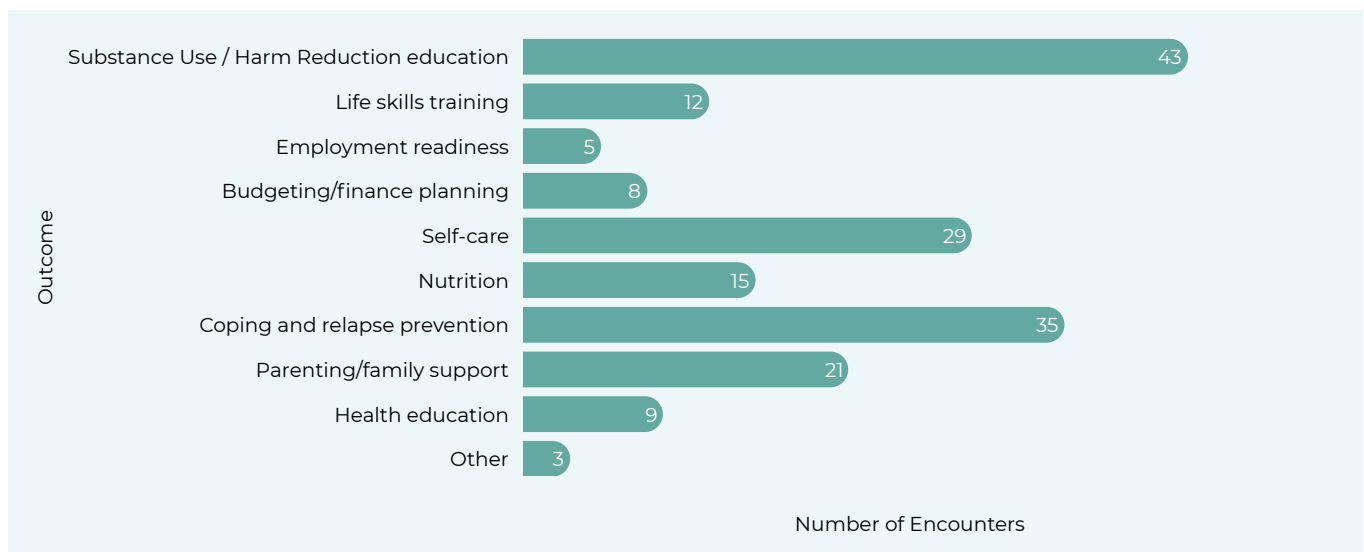
ENCOUNTER METRICS- ADDICTIONS WORKERS

There were 103 recorded encounters by Addictions Workers between January - March, 2026.



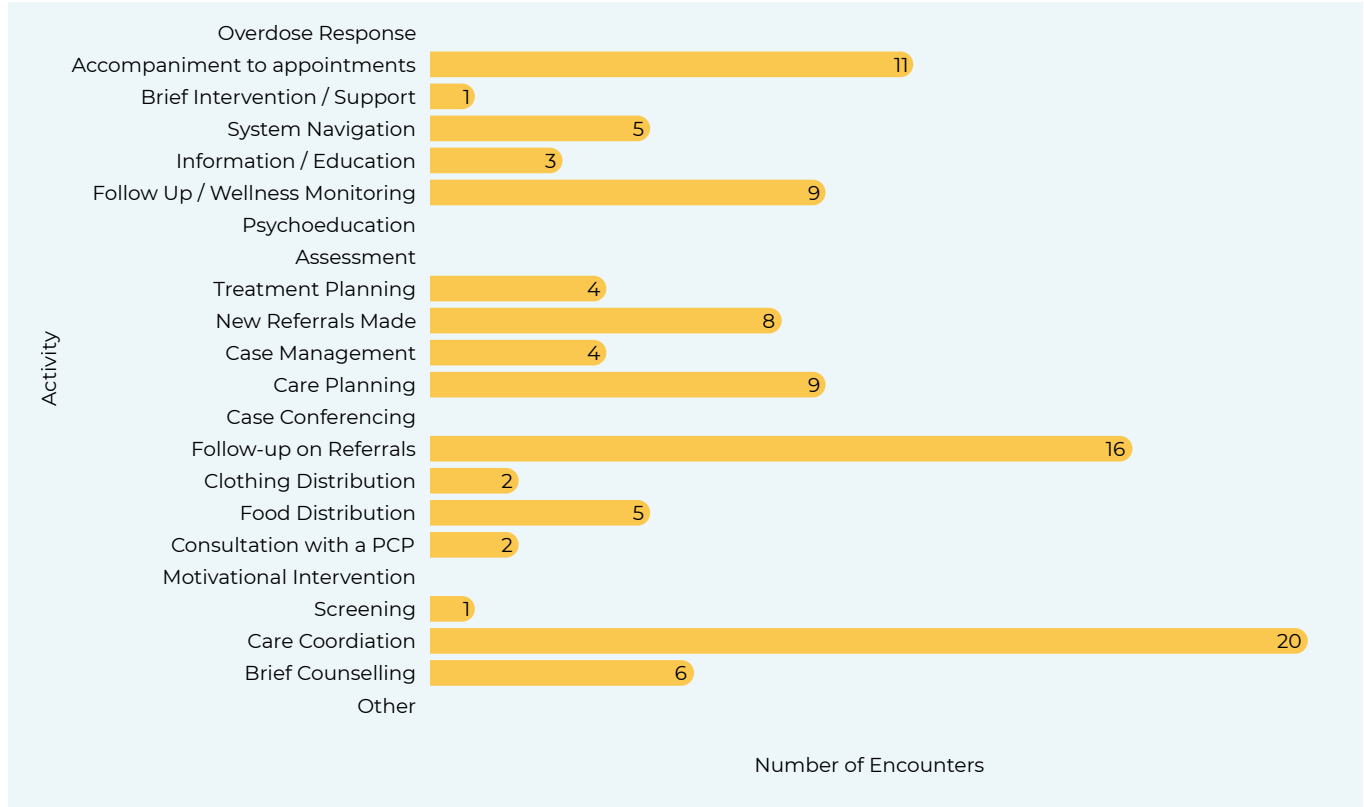
Skill Building Areas



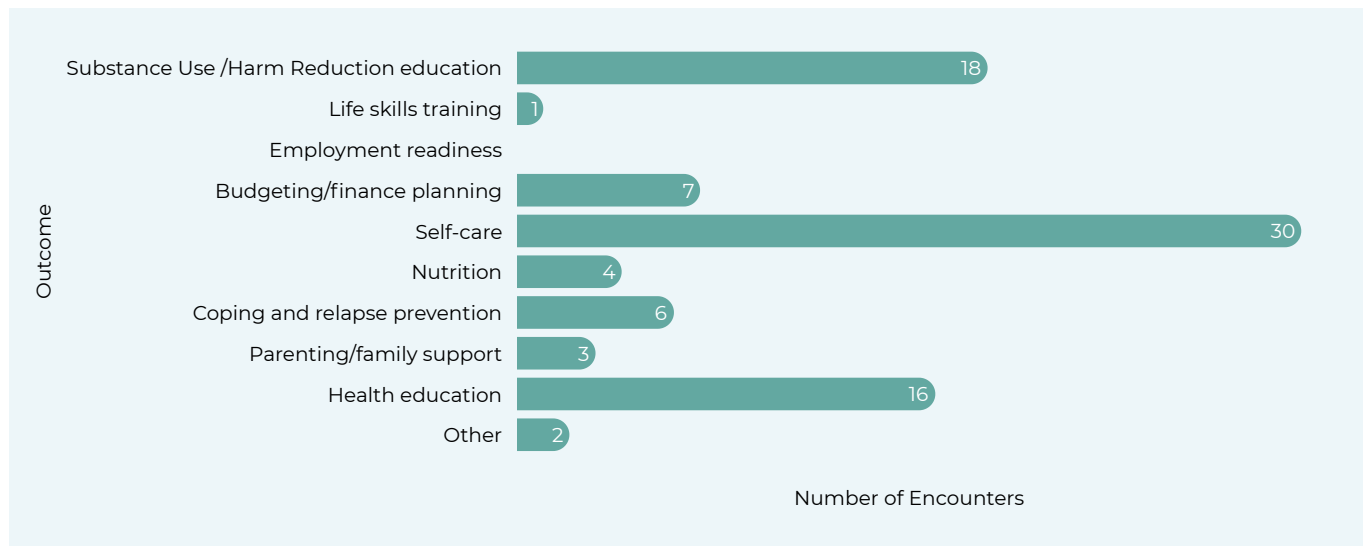
ENCOUNTER METRICS- CARE COORDINATORS

There were 47 recorded encounters by Care Coordinators between January - March 2026.



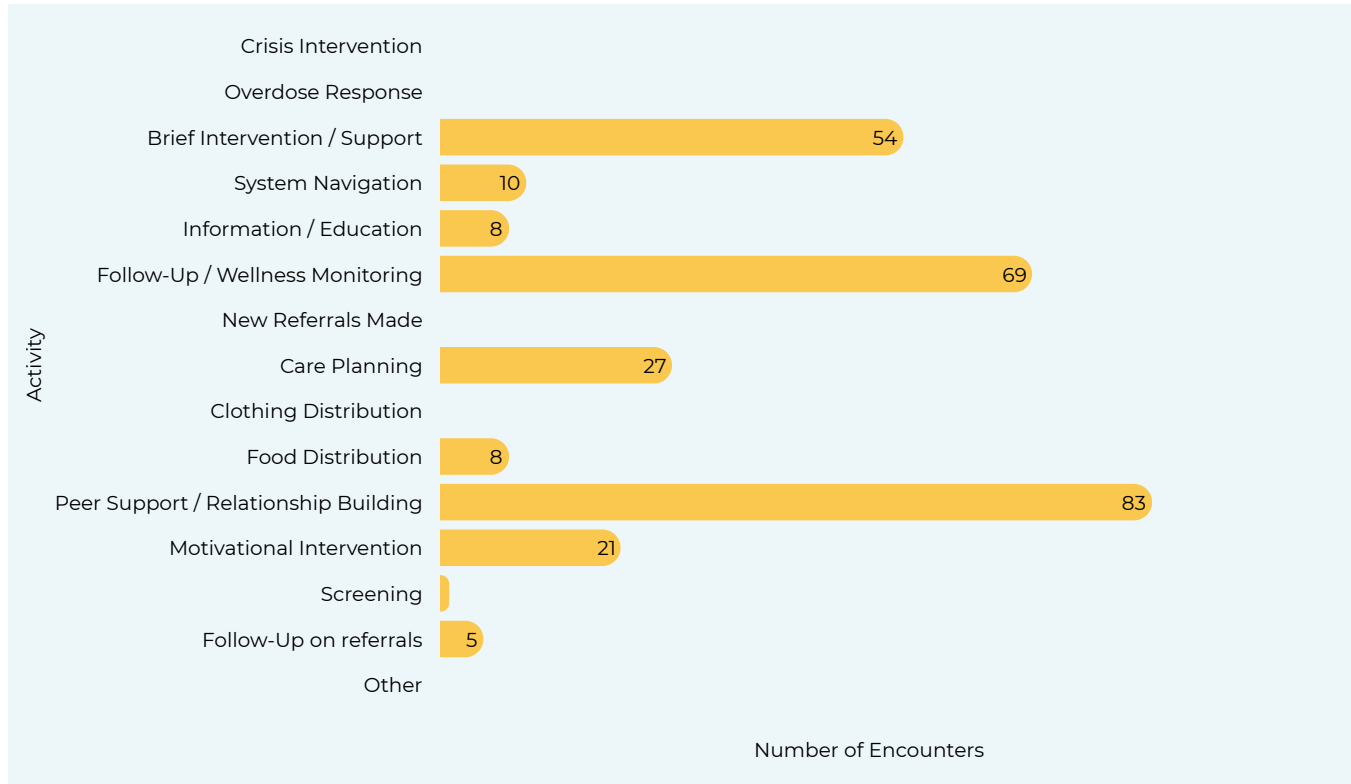

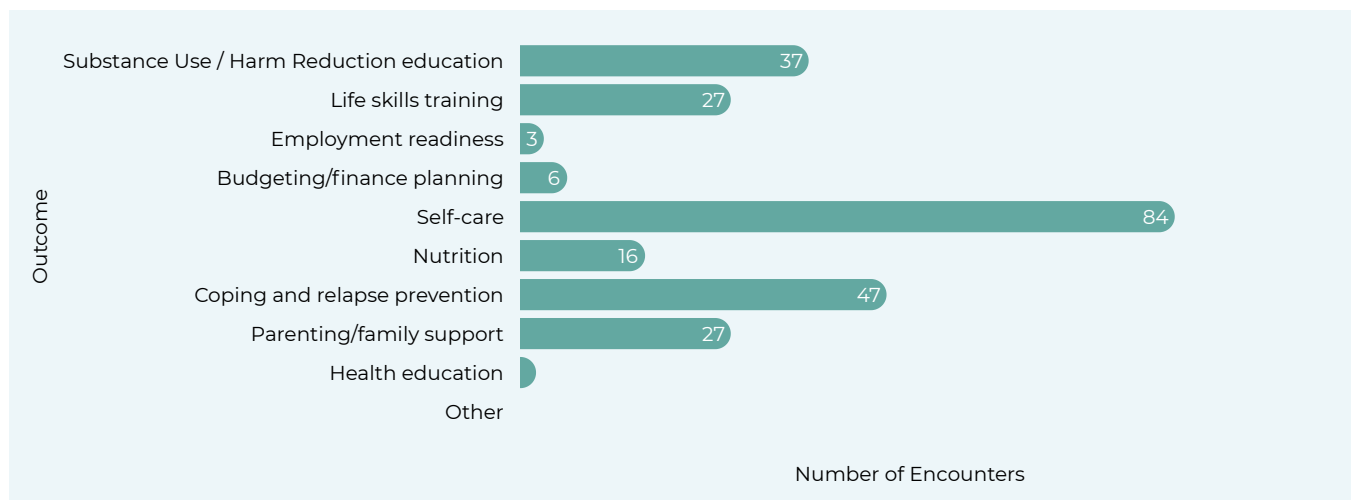
ENCOUNTER METRICS- PEER SUPPORT SPECIALISTS

ENCOUNTER METRICS

Harm Reduction

Of all encounters, **48%** provided substance use / harm reduction education.



As of March 2026, the Mesa Mobile Outreach Team has started distribution of harm reduction supplies to clients.

While it's still early in tracking the distribution of harm reduction supplies, **4** Naloxone kits have been provided, **3** clients have accessed harm reduction supplies, and **6** clients have received education on Naloxone kits, harm reduction, and safer sex.

Referrals

258 referrals were made to services, including the SUAP funded outreach team.



Basic Needs

72 items related to basic needs were distributed across 235 encounters.
